KATAKWI CHURCH ROOF REPAIR

In our February newsletter, we shared about this project. Here is an update...

The community uses this building for meetings, gatherings, and for children coming for choir. There are plans for a tailoring center to use the building as well, to train young people who are jobless. The cost of the roof with timbers would be \$5,000 and it would be a metal roof (iron sheets). The local builders would be the ones contracted to build it and gives them a livelihood and a way to support their families. This project would give hope and excitement to the area. Seeing a church develop creates a picture of permanence and vision. The tailoring school would have a permanent place for the young adults of the area to come to be trained and be sheltered. This would increase the potential of the neighbourhood, where through love in action, development, understanding and cooperation exhibits the love of Christ.
